6. EXCEPTIONS: THIS STANDARD SIGN IS NOT REQUIRED IN THE CHICAGO, IL AREA ON THE FOLLOWING SUBDIVISIONS THAT ARE LEGISLATED QUIET ZONES ALTHOUGH DO NOT HAVE WHISTLE POSTS INSTALLED, EXCEPT THOSE CROSSINGS NOTED WHICH TRAINS ARE REQUIRED TO SOUND ITS WHISTLE:
  - a) HARVARD SUBDIVISION - MP 0.44 TO 62.8
  - b) GENEVA SUBDIVISION - MP 10.0 TO 36.1 (EXCLUDING KILBOURN AVE, MP 5.22 AND 25TH AVE, MP 11.80)
  - c) MILWAUKEE SUBDIVISION - MP 2.6 TO 31.5 (EXCLUDING TOUHY AVE, MP 8.75)
  - d) MILWAUKEE SUBDIVISION - MP 46.0 TO 46.5
  - e) KENOSHA SUBDIVISION - MP 0.0 TO 45.2 (EXCLUDING MLK BLVD, MP 32.98)
